You can help build the Church of the future by investing in the ordinands of today.

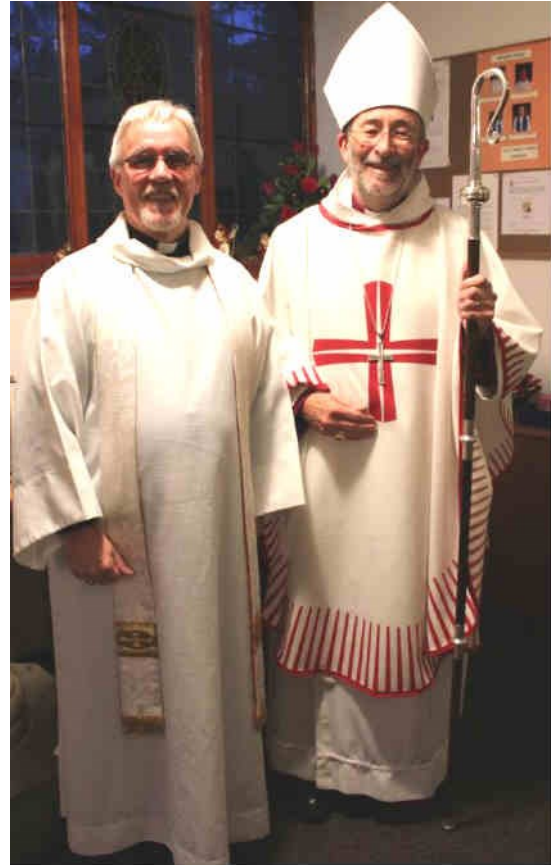
