## Cycling for Charity Around Swaziland

**30 June—12 July 2017**

The Anglican Church in Swaziland through its social development office has a number of programs that it does to mitigate poverty, HIV/Aids and Climate Change to mention but a few. The church through this office feeds more than 500 children daily. The church has more than 15 000 children under its care in its 26 schools around the country and it has played a major role in trying to look after the needy pupils in these schools by donating school uniforms, school shoes and co-ordinating the food supply for school feeding. The Meteorological department has reported that there are more than 60% chances of El'nino (drought) hitting Swaziland again in the current year. This will mean more problems for Swaziland at a time when it is still recovering from another drought season. A group of 6 young people from the Diocese of Swaziland will embark on a 450km cycling around Swaziland to try and raise funds for the Diocesan Social Department and we request your support in sponsoring these young people as they try to make a difference in the lives .
