Brzchin, Iowa Swaziland Visits in 2019

Part 3 of the Young Adults' Exchange Visits - Our Companions in Iowa are planning to host Part Three of these exchange visits in Iowa in August 2019. Proposed dates are 6th August to 18th August 2019. This would be 10 day visit and it is suggested that each group be made up of two age groups - three young adults aged around 18 - 23 and three aged around 24 - 32.

Six young adults from each of the three dioceses would meet in Iowa and spend time living together, studying, worshipping, travelling and enjoying social events.

Diocese of Swaziland. Triennial Diocesan Synod and Working group Visit -

The Diocese of Swaziland Synod is due to be held in the second half of September. It is intended that we combine this visit with a working party visit from Iowa, to continue work on projects begun during the working visit in September 2017. This is planned as a 10 day visit and as usual groups would stay at Thokosa - the Diocesan Church Centre. The visit in 2017 was considered by everyone to be very worthwhile and enjoyable. Proposed dates are 30th September to 11th October 2019.
